

#### Early Communication Instruction



During Lent our congregation will offer once again Early Communion instruction for grade five and

# Tallmadge Christian Preschool is Now Registering for the 2018–2019 School Year!

#### Classes offered 2018-2019

**3-4 year old Class** will be offered for children who will be 3 by September 1st. Classes will be held 9:00-11:30 am on Tuesdays and Thursdays OR Wednesdays and Fridays.

**4-5 year old Class** is held Monday, Wednesday, and Friday mornings either 9:00-11:30 am OR 12:15-2:45 pm. These classes are for students who will be 4 by September 1st and may or may not be attending kindergarten the following Fall.

**Pre-K Class** is held Monday through Friday mornings 9:00-11:30 am. These classes are for students who are 4 by September 1st, will be attending kindergarten the following Fall, AND have completed 1 year of preschool prior to the start of the first class.

**Me and My Grown Up!** This class is held on Mondays from 9:00 to 10:30 am and is for children 2 years old by May 1st and accompanied by a grown up (parent, grandparent or caregiver). The grownup stays with the child during class and helps introduce preschool fun during the classes. Children do not need to be potty-trained to attend this class since an adult will be present at all times. We ask that the same adult attend each class to help with the routine of the class. Due to the limited space in the classroom, siblings not enrolled in the class are not able to attend.
