Have you ever been a part of a *movement*? Merriam Webster's Online Dictionary defines a *movement* as a series of organized activities working toward an objective; an organized effort to promote or attain an end. Several examples of

this include the civil rights *movement and* a *movement* to increase the minimum wage.

This November, I am joining a movement to raise prostate cancer awareness for men by forgoing shaving. (maybe I will look like this picture by the first of December...probably not!) Several members of TLC have been diagnosed with prostate cancer, have received treatment, and are survivors. But we don't really talk much about it.

Did you know?

Other than skin cancer, prostate cancer is the most common cancer in American men. The American Cancer Society's estimates for prostate cancer in the United States for 2018 are:

- About 164,690 new cases of prostate cancer
- About 29,430 deaths from prostate cancer
- About 1 in 9 men will be diagnosed with prostate cancer during his lifetime. The average age at the time of diagnosis is about 66.
- Prostate cancer is the second leading cause of cancer death in American men, behind lung cancer. About 1 man in 41 will die of prostate cancer.
- Prostate cancer can be a serious disease, but most men diagnosed with prostate cancer do not die from it. In fact, more than 2.9 million men in the United States who have been diagnosed with prostate cancer at some point are still alive today.


