reason only — because the creator of the test took the test for you. All your study time, class time and hard work in preparation for this exam did not help you get the "A". You have just experienced — GRACE."

Paul wrote to Titus: "For the grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to all men" (Titus 2:11). Grace is unmerited favor, getting something we don't deserve. What we deserve is a punishment that is fit for the crime – that is a punishment that is equal with our sin.

But this is the Good News...instead of pouring out His wrath upon us; however, God extends His grace towards us. He doesn't turn a blind eye to our sin because that would violate His holiness; nor does He offer us forgiveness; He offers complete justification – forgive and forget – clean slate. God declares us to be righteous through faith in Jesus Christ. A pure gift of GRACE!

My pray for you is that this GRACE may change you from the inside out to become more and more like Jesus Christ.




