FREEDOM 2020

Did you know, of the 38 recorded parables of Jesus, 16 deal with money or possessions. In the Gospels, one out of ten verses (288 in all) deal directly with the subject of money. The Bible offers 500

verses on prayer, less than 500 on faith, but more than 2,000 verses on money and possessions. Perhaps the reason the Bible puts such an emphasis on money is because, in Jesus' words, "Where your treasure is, there your heart will be also." (Matt. 6:21)

I would have thought He would have said, "Where your heart is, your treasure will be also," but your heart follows your treasure. If you put your treasure in the things of this world, your heart will be in this world. If you put your treasure in the kingdom of God, your heart will be there. Since your heart and your money are so inextricably bound together, it is crucial to your spiritual life to study what Scripture teaches about money.

God wants all of us to be at peace with possessions and to experience freedom from bondage to anyone or anything. He wants His children to master their money, rather than be mastered by it. So what does God's Word say about our financial planning and how we can achieve financial freedom? What do you think?

- Are you at peace financially?
- Do you feel enslaved by financial matters or possessions?
- Is God honored with the way you handle your money?
- Why do you think Jesus spoke more often about money and possessions than any other subject in the gospels?





There is much haggling and squabbling over money. Almost every family has experienced this. Marriages even sometimes

split over debt disagreements. Perhaps you are in financial bondage; why not ask yourself the following questions:

- Do you charge daily expenditures because you don't have enough cash to pay for them?
- Do you find yourself putting off paying bills or paying them at the last minute because of a lack of money?
- Do you borrow money to pay fixed expenses such as taxes, insurance, or rent?
- Do you find yourself unaware of just how much you owe?
- Have you taken new loans to pay off old ones?
- Do you argue over finances with your spouse?
- Have you ever thought about being dishonest money, such as cheating on income tax or participating in an unethical financial deal?
- Do you find it difficult to return God's tithe?
- Do you rationalize withholding from His offering?

If you answered yes to several of these questions, you are in financial bondage. If you don't agree, then how would you define financial bondage? God is opposed to any kind of bondage that enslaves us. He wants to break those shackles and set us FREE to be slaves of Christ, Who is the only Master Who wants His servants to have freedom, fulfillment, prosperity, and power.

Even a wealthy person may feel the false self-assurance. You may feel you have plenty of security, so financial bondage is the least of your worries. Yet you may be in great trouble.

- Do you find yourself putting more faith in your money than in God?
- Do you continue to ask God for your daily bread?

If you think that is unnecessary, you are putting your faith in your wealth. If your personal goals in life are no longer God's goals, you are in bondage.

I believe that Financial Peace University will help TLC carry out its mission of Growing as disciples of Christ, Caring for one another and Sharing the love of Jesus in our community. And as we observe the 60th Anniversary of TLC in 2020, a church-wise Financial Peace University Campaign **FREEDOM 2020** will help us celebrate our congregation's past while building momentum for the future.

- We believe FREEDOM 2020 will produce a radical shift in our church culture, setting people free in every area of their life, even beyond their finances. And I believe that the change in our church can be a catalyst for change in our community.
- We hope to strengthen families and improve marriages by opening up lines of communication about finances in the home with practical tips and common goals to unite families.
- We believe that it will unite our church body as we become like-minded about how we should handle our finances according to God's word.
- We believe that friendships will be built and strengthened as we walk this path together and grow with each other, even when it is hard.




