

Many times I've heard people say, "My situation is hopeless." They feel as if they're looking down a long, dark tunnel with no way out. During this season of COVID19 and unrest in our county, it can be challenging to know where to look to for hope. Because of Jesus' life, death and resurrection, our reality as believers in Christ is that there no such thing as a hopeless situation. Although we experience pain, difficulties, and confusion, we have an anchor of hope that keeps us from drifting into despair.

Hebrews 6:19



The main reason a ship needs an anchor is to ride out storms so that it is not blown off course or into the rocks or reefs nearby. Even in a safe harbor, a ship needs an anchor so that it will not drift, hit something and sink. Unless anchors are dropped into the sea, they are useless.

In the same way, God has provided in His Son Jesus Christ to be our anchor of hope. Jesus is our anchor and our source of stability. When we focus on our troubles, we are tossed about without a firm foundation. But when we concentrate on God's character and promises, we'll remember that the Lord always works situations out for our good—even when we don't understand how. So whether we're facing an uncertain outcome or a situation we can't change, we remember that God is faithful.

Hebrews 6:19 calls this anchor of hope both "firm and secure," which means our hope is certain and provides stability even when the harshest winds of adversity blow. The author of Hebrews was writing to people who were facing hardship and persecution



because of their Christian faith. A few were tempted to abandon Christ and return to Judaism. He is urging them to persevere by putting their focus on the superiority of Jesus Christ and the salvation that He has provided. He is trying to instill in them biblical hope—not just a positive, cheerful disposition—but a steady attitude of joy based on the promises of God, who cannot lie.

For followers of Jesus, instead of going down into the ocean, this anchor of hope God gives to us goes up into the heavens, behind the veil, where Jesus has entered as a forerunner for us. He has become our high priest forever. God's Word is reminding us:



The certain hope of our future salvation is an anchor to steady our souls while we wait on God in present storms.

The lesson of the anchor for us is: There has never been anyone who trusted in God's promises and was finally disappointed. God may delay the visible answers to His promises, because He always answers in his time, not in ours. We may not see the answer until we're in heaven. But He is utterly trustworthy to keep His Word. If He has promised eternal salvation to the one who has faith in Jesus, you can count on it as absolutely true!

On October 25, TLC will observe its 60th anniversary as a congregation. 60 years of worship, of teaching, of fellowship, of sharing Jesus with others. 60 years of baptisms, weddings, and funerals. 60 years of being anchored in Christ. My prayer for you and TLC is that together, by God's grace, we may be anchored in hope for another 60 years and many more connecting people to Jesus.

Christy Wahl's Sweet Potato Casserole


6 cups sweet potatoes, peeled, chopped, cooked and cooled slightly

- 1 cup brown sugar
- 4 eggs
- 1 cup milk
- 1 1/2 sticks butter
- 2 tsp vanilla

Topping

- 1 cup brown sugar
- 1/2 cup flour
- 1/2 cup coconut flakes
- 1 cup chopped walnuts
- 1 stick butter

Preheat over to 350. Mix all casserole ingredients together and pour into 9x13 dish. Mix together all topping ingredients and crumble over top of casserole. Bake 350 for 45 min or until browned and bubbly.


