### **Words of Institution**

- **Luke 22:19** - *And He took bread, and when He had given thanks, He broke it and gave it to them, saying, "This is my \_\_\_\_\_, which is given for you. Do this in remembrance of Me."*
- **Matthew 26:27-28** - *And He took a cup, and when He had given thanks He gave it to them, saying, "Drink of it, all of you, for this is my \_\_\_\_\_ of the covenant, which is poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins."*

### **How do we approach Communion and what does it mean?**

- Communion is important as an \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ celebration.

- **1 Corinthians 10:16-17** - Communion is a \_\_\_\_\_ in the body and blood of Christ and Jesus is present in the bread and wine.
- **1 Corinthians 11:26** - When we celebrate the Lord's Supper we are proclaiming Jesus' \_\_\_\_\_ until He returns.
- **1 Corinthians 11:27-30** - We are to \_\_\_\_\_ ourselves before we take Communion, recognizing our sin and need for Jesus.

**Main Point:** Jesus shows us amazing \_\_\_\_\_ by serving us and offering Himself in the Lord's Supper.

*Philippians 2:3-8 - 3 Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. Rather, in humility value others above yourselves, 4 not looking to your own interests but each of you to the interests of the others. 5 In your relationships with one another, have the same mindset as Christ Jesus:*

*6 Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be used to his own advantage; 7 rather, he made himself nothing by taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness. 8 And being found in appearance as a man, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to death—even death on a cross.*
