- **Hebrews 1:3** - *'He is the radiance of the glory of God and the \_\_\_\_\_ of his nature, and he upholds the universe by the word of his power. After making purification for sins, he sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high.'*
- **Hebrews 1:8** - *'But of the Son he says, "Your throne, O God, is \_\_\_\_\_ and ever, the scepter of uprightness is the scepter of your kingdom.'*
- **Hebrews 2:14-18** - *Since therefore the children share in flesh and blood, he himself likewise partook of the same things, that through death he might destroy the one who has the power of death, that is, the devil...17 Therefore he had to be \_\_\_\_\_ like his brothers in every respect, so that he might become a merciful and faithful high priest in the service of God, to make propitiation for the sins of the people. 18 For because he himself has suffered when tempted, he is able to \_\_\_\_\_ those who are being tempted.*

- **Hebrews 3:3** - *For Jesus has been counted worthy of more glory than \_\_\_\_\_—as much more glory as the builder of a house has more honor than the house itself.*
- **Hebrews 4:14-16** - *Since then we have a great high \_\_\_\_\_ who has passed through the heavens, Jesus, the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession. 15 For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but one who in every respect has been tempted as we are, yet without sin. 16 Let us then with confidence draw near to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need.*
- **Hebrews 7:27** - *He has no need, like those high priests, to offer sacrifices daily, first for his own sins and then for those of the people, since he did this once for all when he offered up himself.*
- **Hebrews 8:7-13** - *Jesus is the author and embodiment of the \_\_\_\_\_*
- **Hebrews 9:22** - *Indeed, under the law almost everything is purified with blood, and without the shedding of \_\_\_\_\_ there is no \_\_\_\_\_ of sins.*

- **Hebrews 3:14** - *For we have come to share in Christ, if indeed we hold our original confidence firm to the \_\_\_\_\_.*

- **Hebrews 11:1 & 6** - Now \_\_\_\_\_ is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen. 6 And without faith it is impossible to please him, for whoever would draw near to God must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who seek him.
- **Hebrews 12:1-3** - Therefore, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of \_\_\_\_\_, let us also lay aside every weight, and sin which clings so closely, and let us run with \_\_\_\_\_ the race that is set before us, 2 looking to \_\_\_\_\_ (fix our eyes), the founder and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is seated at the right hand of the throne of God. 3 Consider him who endured from sinners such hostility against himself, so that you may not grow \_\_\_\_\_ or fainthearted.
