The 10 Commandments 5TH – Don't Murder!! – B14

Memory Verse- Be angry and do not sin; do not let the sun go down on your anger Ephesians 4:26

5th Commandment - 'You shall not _MURDER .' Exodus 20:13

 <u>MURDER</u> - the killing of a human being by a sane person, with intent, malice aforethought and with no legal excuse or authority

God values _LIFE_! This is the story of _SCRIPTURES_ from beginning to end.

- Genesis 1 Creation is all about God breathing <u>LIFE</u> into nothing and is crowned by <u>HUMANS!</u>
- Genesis 1:26- 'Then God said, "Let us make man in our _IMAGE , after our likeness.
- Genesis 2 Perfect relationship with God and the tree of _LIFE_ was in the center!
- Genesis 3 Sin enters the world and brings <u>DEATH</u>, which goes against God's desires. The remainder of Scripture is about God restoring <u>LIFE</u>!
- Revelation 22 This gives us a picture of eternity, which centers on <u>LIFE WITH JESUS</u>!
 - As followers of Jesus, we focus on bringing <u>LIFE</u> to everything around us and this is the heart of the 5th Commandment.

Jesus <u>EXPANDS</u> the 5^{th} Commandment to include <u>HATRED</u> of brother, unforgiveness, unwillingness to reconcile, name calling, wishing evil upon them, and harsh judgment

• Ephesians 4:26 - 'Be _ANGRY and do not sin; do not let the sun go down on your anger.'

The 5th Commandment isn't only about not <u>MURDERING</u> your neighbor, but about <u>HELPING</u>, serving & <u>PROTECTING</u> those in need!

• 1 John 3:15-16 - 'Everyone who hates his brother is a <u>MURDERER</u>, and you know that no murderer has eternal life abiding in him. By this we know love, that he laid down his <u>LIFE</u> for us, and we ought to lay down our <u>LIVES</u> for the brothers.'

'Murder' is a <u>HEART</u> issue, not just a behavior issue---we need to ask God for a change of <u>HEART!</u>

- Matthew 15:19 For out of the <u>HEART</u> come evil thoughts, murder, adultery, sexual immorality, theft, false witness, slander.
 - o 1) We must understand and _BELIEVE_ what God thinks of us
 - o 2) Respond in faith and _TRUST God
 - o 3) We are able to have a healthy love for our _NEIGHBOR_
 - 4) We are able to have a healthy love for _OURSELF_

Main Point: As followers of Jesus, we value <u>LIFE</u> and <u>LOVE</u> our neighbors, because they are made in the <u>IMAGE</u> of God.
