

## Redeemed

"In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace

Ephesians 1:7

There is a story about when a great Parliament of Religions that was held in the city of Chicago in the United States back in 1893. Practically every known religion at that time was represented there. During one of the sessions, a man by the name of Dr Joseph Cook of Boston, a preacher, stood suddenly. He addressed everyone: 'Gentleman, I beg to introduce to you a woman with a great sorrow. Bloodstains are on her hands, and nothing she has tried will remove them. The blood is that of murder. She has been driven to desperation in her distress. Is there anything in your religions that will remove her sin and give her peace?'.

A hush fell on the gathering that day, not one of the company replied. Dr Cook, raising his eyes heavenward, then cried out: 'John!' - meaning the apostle John - 'John, can you tell this woman how to get rid of her awful sin'. The great preacher waited, as if listening for a reply, and suddenly he cried: 'Listen, John speaks!' - and quoting 1 John 1 verse 7 in the Bible, he said, 'The blood of Jesus Christ, God's Son, cleanses us from all sin'.

Not a soul broke the silence. The representatives of the Eastern religions and the Western cults sat dumb. In the face of human need, it was the Gospel of Jesus Christ alone that could meet that need. Only the blood of Jesus shed on the cross at Calvary can erase human sin - and that is the good news of the Gospel that we preach. We read it here in Ephesians 1:7: 'In Him we have redemption', we are bought back from the bondage of our sin, 'through His blood', Jesus' blood, 'the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace'.

In his book *Not Ashamed of the Gospel*, Fleming Rutledge reminds follower of Jesus we must remember there is only one way that we can participate in Christ's victory over the demonic Powers. We can only do it by doing it *His* way. The way of grace. The way of the Gospel. The way through the cross redeemed by the blood of Jesus Christ. For if we try to do it our way, we will fail and we will be back into the rule of Sin and Death. The only way of victory is through the Cross.

Rutledge also makes this observation, "Young people today are faced with so many pressures to assume so many "lifestyles". The messages are all essentially the same... and your lifestyle will be limitless... It's a lie. All of it is a lie. None of these things can give life. The sign of Sin and Death lies across them all. But there is news today. I am among you as a fellow prisoner who brings news of impending release. *The first man, Adam, is strong but the second man, Christ, is stronger still.*" In this month of April and Easter, we celebrate that the second Adam, Jesus Christ, has died on the cross and has defeated all our enemies!

While we can know in our heads that we share in Jesus' victory, sometimes we get overwhelmed by the devil's lies. This month, I challenge you to listen to the voice of Jesus Christ over the lies of the devil. Listen to the voice of Jesus who loves you and who died and rose again so that you might have abundant life now and forever. In her book *Get Out Of Your Head*, Jennie Allen told this story:

My friend Christina, a licensed therapist, tells me that Psychiatry 101 teaches therapists that when you and I choose to believe a lie about ourselves, it's one of these three lies we believe:

I'm helpless.

I'm worthless.

I'm unlovable.



Reflexively I tried to prove her wrong. "Seriously, Christina? Only *three*?" I told her that I've been known to believe three hundred lies about myself—in a day. "Nope," she said. "Each one of those three hundred lies fits into one of these three."

For the sake of argument, let's assume that Christina is right. Which of the three lies do you most struggle against? I pray that the power of Jesus' death and resurrection, the strength of the Holy Spirit and the love of the Father may empower you to trust down the depths of your being and the Lord loves you, God sees great value and worth in you, and that for those redeemed in the blood of Jesus, all things are possible.

# Food Pantry Updates

2021- TLC was able to get 7000 lbs of food valued at \$7,734.00 from the Akron-Canton Regional Foodbank. We did NOT pay a cent, due to grants and funding.

2022- TLC will still be accessing food from the Foodbank, but anticipate it costing \$100- \$150/month to continue to provide food to 20 families on a monthly basis.

HOW can you help continue this vital service to the community?


## Good Friday Men's Prayer Breakfast




