This Easter season through Pentecost Sunday, we will gather together in worship to celebrate and participate in this work as Jesus promises to provide:



## **Kairos Toledo Correctional**

I wanted to share with everyone what happened on the Kairos weekend that all of you from Tallmadge Lutheran supported with cookie, money, and most importantly prayer. Twenty-four residents participated. Of those, Twenty-three completed the weekend. The Saturday following the weekend, we had an instructional day with the residents to help them setup small groups which we call Prayer and Share that meets weekly for Christian support. Twenty of the residents attended that. As part of the celebration, the prison Chaplin performed nine baptisms of which six of the baptisms were men that were part of the weekend. This included one resident that claimed that he had a devout belief in Asatru, which is the belief in the Icelandic Norse gods. When he heard the message of Christ, he gave his life to Christ.

I am always amazed at how Christ uses a few cookies to create a miraculous change in people's lives.

The next weekend is scheduled for September 22 - 25. If anyone is interested in volunteering to participate for both male or female incarcerated, please let me know. I can help direct you to the various programs at any of the prisons in Ohio.

Thank you everyone, and please continue to pray for these people and this ministry.


