Where is the Holy Spirit Today?

The Day of Pentecost is always a great celebration for the church. We will gather together to celebrate Pentecost on Sunday, June 5, to hear the story of the birth of the Church, told in Acts 2: When the Holy Spirit came upon the apostles like the rush of a violent wind, with tongues as of fire dancing on their heads; people from all nations hearing the apostles speaking in their own language, and more than 3,000 responding by being baptized into Christ.

Don't you wonder a little, when you hear the Pentecost account, whether we are missing something today? After all, I doubt that our Pentecost celebration at TLC will include a violent wind, or fire, or miraculous speech. So are we missing something? Where is the wind and the fire today? Where is the excitement of that first Pentecost? Perhaps the better question to ask is: **WHERE IS THE HOLY SPIRIT TODAY?** After all, isn't that the point of Pentecost? To give us the Holy Spirit? So the question to ask today is not, where is the wind and the fire, but where is the Holy Spirit?

This month, I hope to remind you that the Holy Spirit is without a doubt here with us even today, in some very amazing and powerful ways. Let me share three of those ways:

The Word of God - First, the Holy Spirit is here, and comes to us today, through the Holy Word – the divinely-inspired, faith-producing, life-changing Word of God – which connects us to all Christians going all the way back to that first Pentecost, and connects us to the God who inspired and guided its every word.

The Called and Gathered Church - The second way that the Holy Spirit comes to us today is through the gathered congregation. As Martin Luther put it in his Small Catechism:

The Holy Spirit calls, gathers, enlightens, and makes holy the whole Christian church on earth and keeps it with Jesus Christ in the one common, true faith.



The Holy Spirit is the reason TLC exists today. The Holy Spirit called and gathered us here at TLC just as it has done for Christian communities for centuries all around the world. The Holy Spirit brings us together and gives us a variety of gifts, all for the common good. We come together to share our gifts and insights, and become more than we can possibly be, on our own. Through the Holy Spirit, Jesus is present when we gather in his name, which we do whenever we worship together. The Holy Spirit can come to us when we are alone, of course, but scripture teaches us that coming together in Jesus' name is the best way to discover the Holy Spirit among us.

The Sacraments - And finally, the Holy Spirit comes to us through the Holy Sacraments. When Peter finished his sermon on that first Pentecost, those who heard it asked him, "What should we do?" And Peter responded, "Repent, and be baptized ... and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit" (Acts 2:37-38). They will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit not through wind and fire, but through holy baptism. And it is in baptism that we, too, first received the gift of the Holy Spirit.

And right after those who heard Peter's sermon were baptized, what did they do? The very next verse says, "They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and fellowship, to the breaking of bread and the prayers" (Acts 2:42). In other words, they gathered together as a community, to hear the Word and celebrate Holy Communion.



That is where the miracle of Pentecost continued to be enjoyed and realized in the Church. Then, and now. When we gather in the name of Jesus, remember our baptisms, devote ourselves to the apostles' teaching, and to the breaking of the bread, and the prayers.

It's always tempting to think that we need more – we need more excitement, more enthusiasm, more emotion; we need more wind and fire on Sunday mornings. But we Lutherans are at our best when we refuse to believe that the church needs anything more than the Word, the congregation gathered in Jesus' name, and the Sacraments. Because we believe, teach and confess that it is through these means of grace that God gives us all that we need for our salvation.

Know that the Lord has filled you with His Holy Spirit to love God and love others!

Experience the Holy Land with Pastor Andy January 17-26, 2024

Pastor Andy Alberts is hosting a trip to Israel (with an optional Egypt extension) traveling January 17-26, 2024.

Highlights of this trip include 3 days exploring the area of Galilee including a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee, visiting Nazareth, Caesarea Philippi, Mt. of Beatitudes, and Magdala.

On the way to Jerusalem, we will stop at the Jordan River and Beit Shean—one of the best-preserved Decapolis Roman Cities. In the three days in and around Jerusalem, we will visit the Mt. of Olives, the Western Wailing Wall, parts of the Via Dolorosa, the Church of the Holy Sepulcher that contains the traditional site of Jesus' death and tomb, the Shrine of the Book Museum, Hezekiah's Tunnel (weather permitting), and have a communion worship service at a secondary site for Golgotha and the Garden Tomb.

There will be a day trip south of Jerusalem to see Qumran where the Dead Sea Scrolls were authored and discovered, to the Ein Gedi caves where David hid from King Saul, to see King Herod's fortress at Masada, and to the Dead Sea for a swim/float.

The tour price of \$4,597 per person, based on double occupancy, includes airfare from Cleveland, first class hotels, breakfasts, and dinners (lunches are on your own), guided site-seeing, entrance fees, and gratuities.




