## What is Baptism?

Baptism is not just plain water, but it is the water included in God's command and combined with God's Word.

## Which is that word of God?

Christ our Lord says in the last chapter of Matthew: "Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit." [Matthew 28:19]

The word, *Baptize* means to <u>apply water</u> by immersing, washing, pouring, and the like. Some people insist that this word must mean immerse. This is certainly one of the meaning, but it is unlikely that people at the time of Jesus immersed themselves and their tables, cups, pitchers, and kettles under water each time they "washed."
