Extra Baptism Discussion Questions

- 2. Suppose that the minister who baptized you, later abandoned the Christian faith, and even became an atheist. Would this affect your baptism?
- 3. Someone agrees to become baptized, but wants nothing to do with the church, and also refuses to be instructed in the Christian Faith. What would you say to this person? Should you (or a pastor) baptize this person?
- 4. You are a nurse in a hospital. A child is born that is not expected to live. There is no pastor at hand; the parents request the child be baptized. Would you baptize the child? What if the parents were of a different denomination?
- 5. An adult receives instruction in the Christian faith and wishes to join a Christian congregation. He cannot remember whether or not he was baptized as a child, and there is no way of determining if he was baptized. Should such a person be baptized?
