Sunday, September 11 FOR – Jesus

The Bible says that "God is love" (1 John 4:8). The ultimate act of God's love for all people and all of creation was the death of His own Son, Jesus Christ, on the cross. When we stand for Jesus, we are standing for truth that Jesus is the Savior of the World, for "there is no other name under heaven given to men by which we must be saved" (Acts 4:12). When we stand for Jesus, we are standing for love... sacrificial love, love that keeps on loving even when getting nothing back in return, love that never fails. At the heart and head of the Christian Church on earth is Jesus Christ and His call for his followers to "love one another as I have loved you" (John 15:12).





Sunday, September 18 FOR – Grace/Forgiveness

Every Sunday, when we pray the Lord's Prayer, we pray, "Forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us." Forgiveness is central for following Jesus and being the Church. Jesus prayed from the cross, "Father forgive them, they do not know what they are doing" (Luke 23:34). Peter was told by Jesus that he should forgive, not 7 times, but

seventy-seven times (Matthew 18:22). On Resurrection Sunday, when Jesus appeared to his disciples, he breathed on them the Holy Spirit and said, "If you forgive anyone his sins, they are forgiven; if you do not forgive them, they are not forgiven" (John 20:23). As Christ's Church on earth, we share the forgiveness we have received.



Sunday, September 25 FOR – Life

Human life is not an achievement. Life is a gift. Life has measureless value, because every individual, at every stage of development and every state of consciousness, is known and loved by God. This is the source of human dignity and the basis for human equality. It must

therefore be asserted without exception or qualification: No one is worthless whom God has created and for whom Christ died. In Christ, God gives us eyes of life — eyes that see life from His perspective. And what we see causes us to stand for and speak for life.



Sunday, October 2 FOR – Family

Jesus didn't just come to save us from our sins, He came to adopt us into his family and to begin to live His life through us. Paul puts it this way in Ephesians 2:19-20 – "Consequently, you are no longer foreigners and aliens, but fellow citizens with God's people and members of God's household, built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, with Christ Jesus himself as the chief cornerstone." As a family, we care for one another, support one another,

comfort each other, laugh together, mourn together, and do life together. And the family is never big enough! There is plenty of room for more. No matter what our relationships are like with our blood family, our Heavenly Father welcomes us into his eternal family through faith in Jesus Christ.



Sunday, October 9 FOR – Sent to Serve

Just as God sent his Son to us, He is also sending you to serve. To follow Jesus is to become like Jesus. To become like Jesus is to become a servant. Jesus explained to his disciples, "The Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many" (Matthew 20:28). Through our service, we get to show the world what Jesus is like. God is doing something bigger than changing how we act, he's changing who we are. And you

are a follower of Jesus sent to serve.

I hope and pray that you will be able to join the family of God at TLC for worship in-person or online as we unite and stand FOR Jesus Christ in this world.

At the conclusion of this time of instruction, parents will be able to discern if their child is ready to receive the Lord's Supper.




Gail,

In my spare time I love to read and play with lots of different art supplies.


