# LIVING LIGHT

#### Leaning Towards the Light



Have you heard of **phototropism**? It is a survival mechanism in which a plant grows towards the greatest source of light in an effort to jumpstart the process of photosynthesis. Picture the Leaning Tower of Pisa, only it's a

plant! Phototropism is a turning and stretching of the plant's cells towards its source of energy. This reach for the sun is initiated by auxin, a plant hormone that regulates growth. This internal orientation towards the light makes it possible for a plant to thrive even in most adverse conditions.



Just like plants need light to grow and thrive, you and I need to exposure to Jesus. In fact, I think our measure of spiritual growth is entirely dependent upon our exposure to Jesus! When we soak in God's Word, we grow in Jesus. When we absorb the Lord's Supper, we receive nutrients for our soul. When we turn to the promises the God has given us in baptism, Jesus jump starts our growth, our renewal and restoration.



But what happens to plants when they have no light? Plants can still survive, but nothing green grows in darkness because of the lack of sunlight. In our spiritual walk, nothing of spiritual significance can be birthed within us without the illumination of God's Son. As we enter into the season of Lent on Ash Wednesday, February 22, I challenge you to consider how much exposure you are receiving from the Son, our Savior Jesus Christ. The measure of our spiritual growth is dependent upon position toward Jesus. Are we positioned to take in the presence of Jesus or not?

In his *Pensées*, a collection of thoughts written by the French 17<sup>th</sup>-century philosopher and mathematician Blaise Pascal, Pascal wrote "...there was once in man a true happiness, of which there now remain to him, the mark and empty trace, which he in vain tries to fill from all his surroundings... but these are all inadequate, because the infinite abyss can only be filled by an infinite and immutable object, that is to say, only by God himself."



Lent represents a time when we can take inventory of our search for "true happiness." moving away from a caveman-like existence which has left us spiritually blind and wanting in order to move

towards the light that will renew our growth. My prayer this Lent is that each of us can find ways to lean towards the light, orient ourselves towards Jesus, and position ourselves so that we can soak up his presence and take in his spiritual nourishment.



On Sundays this Lenten season, we will hear accounts of individuals who have leaned towards the light, made their way to Jesus, soaked up his presence, and discovered life. Like us, they are flawed individuals, skeptics like Nicodemus (John 3:1-17) on March 5, outsiders, like the Samaritan woman (John 4:5-42) on March 12, physically broken, like the blind man (John 9:1-41) on March 19, or lost in the darkness and gloom of death itself, like Lazarus (John 11:1-45)

on March 26. This set of four individuals leaning in towards the light are surrounded by two stories of Jesus' own full presence in the light of God the Father found in the stories of his temptation in the wilderness (Matthew 4:1-11) on February 26 and his Passion (Matthew 26:14-27:66) on April 2.

Together, let us Lean Towards the Light-Soaking up the Presence of Jesus!




