#### **Teach Us to Pray**

In Luke 11:1, the disciples asked Jesus, "Teach us to pray." Our Lord must have beamed with joy at the opportunity to teach his beloved friends how to connect with and enjoy fellowship with the Father. In just a few short sentences, Jesus gave his followers a timeless prayer containing the most important things we need to know and believe.

Every single phrase of The Lord's Prayer connects us to God's answers to the things that concern us the most. This June and July, we will take a closer look at the Lord's Prayer and what it means to be connected to God and to one another – restoring hope in these uncertain times.



You might be thinking, "But I know all about the Lord's Prayer. I pray it every week!" The Lord's Prayer is not just a prayer; it's a vision for life in Christ's inbreaking kingdom. It's an acknowledgment of the brokenness, hunger, and evil that is present in this world. It's a statement of faith, a call to worship, and a battle cry. It's a bold pleading for heaven-on-earth transformation-that all people and all things come under the reign of Jesus Christ in His kingdom.



Prayer is an invitation to connect to God—Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. It is not as if God "needs" our prayers in order to gather accurate information. God doesn't need our prayers, but we need to pray. We pray in order to express our complete dependence upon our Heavenly Father. We pray to build our faith. We pray because He is God and we are not. We pray because God has filled us with the Holy Spirit so that our prayers are part of His unfolding plan for the universe.



Picture this...a father is watching his four-year-old daughter trying to put together a puzzle. She tries and tries but she just can't get the pieces in the right place. Her father watches with great interest but he doesn't interfere. Finally, she crawls in his lap and says, "Daddy, would you help me put my puzzle together?" He smiles and bends down and together they begin to pick up each piece. One by one they put the puzzle together.

Why didn't the father help his daughter earlier? For one thing, she didn't ask for his help. For another, he wanted her to try on her own. And most of all, he wanted her to ask him for his help. When she did, he was honored and gladly helped her finish the puzzle. Is this not a picture of how our Heavenly Father deals with his children? Although he longs to come to our aid, often he waits until we ask him specifically. Sometimes he wants us to come to the end of our own pitiful resources before he intervenes. When we cry out in despair, he is honored as we express our complete dependence upon him.

Every prayer is the cry of a child saying, "Help, Father, I can't do this by myself." I believe that as we learn more about and pray the Lord's Prayer, we'll be moved to embrace childlike dependence, wholehearted worship, love for one another, and participation in God's mission. The Lord's Prayer only makes sense within the context of childlike faith and dependence. We acknowledge it's God's kingdom we live in, not ours. We ask humbly for daily provision, knowing we can't ensure our own survival and flourishing apart from him. We beg for for-



giveness, protection, and deliverance just as a young child asks for help and safety as she prepares to fall asleep at night.

May the Lord draw you into a closer walk with Jesus as we pray the Lord's Prayer together!
