

#### He Is Among Us

Every December during the season of Advent, we take time to prepare our hearts for the arrival of the Messiah. In our Christian faith, we encounter a peculiar truth. Almost every other religion in the world is structured so that humanity has to make its way to God. But in this upside-down, backwards Kingdom of Jesus, God comes to us. In Luke 1:31 Gabriel's announces to Mary that God is about to be among us:



"You will be with child and give birth to a son, and you are to give him the name Jesus. He will be great and will be called the Son of the Most High. The Lord God will give him the throne of his father David, and he will reign over the house of Jacob forever; his kingdom will never end."

In this passage we are told about one of the greatest mysteries of the Christian faith: the Incarnation. Incarnation simply means, "in the flesh." At this stunning moment in history, God's plan for redeeming His people is revealed, and no one could have anticipated His approach. God Almighty determined to set out to save humanity from the inside. The Lord would become one of us. This thought would be scandalous and sacrilegious if it weren't true. But true it is. What a mystery! The Son of the Most High God will also be the son of the humble Mary. Our God is not a far-off deity who demands that we make our way to Him. He comes to us. He is near. He is among us.

The Incarnation, the presence of God as a human, changes everything. It challenges us to live in such a way that we, as children of God, now have God living in us. One pastor calls this transformation of faith to becoming people "where God happens." God's miracles happen in us and through us.



Why would the Lord Almighty and creator of the universe become human? The motivation behind the mission is clear—love. Advent is a proclamation of God's unthinkable love for His people. It is a love that is more than sentiment or intention. It is active and overflowing and even reckless. He risks it all because He is driven by love.

As we look at this broken world and feel overwhelmed by the depravity around us, we sometimes find ourselves in need of denying God's embrace of our utter humanity. We want to make excuses for ourselves saying that we are only human. That we are limited. That we are sinners, that we are broken and cracked beings. That we can't handle the change and suffering in our lives.



But, this is the whole point of Christmas: God becomes what we are so we might become what Jesus is. What we are is this: cracked and broken humans, dead in our sin. What we become through faith in Jesus is: perfect sons and daughters of God redeemed by Jesus' blood shed on the cross fully alive and fully loved.

That first Christmas for Mary and Joseph meant that God was at work on earth. For us in 2023 it means God is still at work on earth. And here's the crazy truth: God accomplishes his work through us! He fills us with the Holy Spirit and nourishes us through His Word and Sacraments to be able to trust Him so that God can work through us to continue to reveal His Son, Jesus Christ, to the world. We have been changed into children of God who have one purpose: to reveal Jesus to the world by loving God and loving others.

God coming near, that is what Christmas is all about; God coming to us to surround us with his love. Immanuel - God with us. Jesus Christ - God redeeming us. Redeemed children of God – God working in and through us.



May the truth of God among you and your family this Christmas season bring you deep joy and profound peace!

Thursday, February 29 6:30pm – 7:45pm


**Episode 8 - Sustenance** *Matthew 14:13-33; Mark 6:34-56; Luke 9:1-17* 


While Jesus preaches to thousands, the disciples realize there is no food.
