Give thanks to the LORD, call on his name; make known among the nations what he has done.

1 Chronicles 16:8

#### What are you thankful for?

At the heart of the Christian life is a spirit of thanksgiving. As we read in the Bible, men and women with great needs encounter Jesus. Even as Jesus knows their immediate physical needs, he reaches down deeper to satisfy their greatest need – their need for a Savior. In response to the healing and forgiveness received, men and women joyful give thanks to the Lord for all that He has done for them.

Christian Sharen writes in *Faith as a Way of Life*: "Christian faith is a gift of God that entails dying to one way of life and rising to another lived not for ourselves, but for God. To receive Christian faith is, in St. Paul's words, "to walk in newness of life" (Romans 6:4). Paul shows that Christian faith is not simply a state of mind or a belief that has no practical consequences for daily living. Rather, it is a way of life marked by the mysterious union with Christ described by Paul in these words: 'it is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me (Galatians 2:20)... Christian faith, then, is God's gift, not just of salvation and new life, but of a *whole new way of life* 'in Christ."

Other ideas are available, as well, but these twelve (12) are needed now: girls' shorts sizes L and XL, hoodies very gently loved or new – all sizes, duffel bags, large tote bags/grocery bags, Legos, baby wipes, new t-shirts – all sizes, bottled water, drawstring bags, and cleaning supplies (i.e., Lysol spray, toilet bowl cleaner, disinfectant wipes, sponges, dish soap, etc.).

Thanks for your help, and we look forward to doing our part at this time. This is always an amazing time to sing with our choir and we want to include everyone who is interested.




