**Memory Verse of the Week:** *And Moses said to the people, "Fear not, stand firm, and see the \_\_\_\_\_ of the Lord, which He will work for you today." Exodus 14:13*

Genesis thru Deuteronomy were written by \_\_\_\_\_ and are also called the Torah & Pentateuch.

- **Exodus 3** - God appears to Moses in a burning \_\_\_\_\_ and Moses will lead His people out of \_\_\_\_\_. Moses responds to God's call with doubts, but God meets them with promise!
- There was no significant reason \_\_\_\_\_ was chosen and he was adopted, worshipped pagan gods, and was a murderer.
  - **Ex. 3:14** - ' \_\_\_\_\_ ' sent you---same phrase Jesus uses in the New Testament

God used 10 \_\_\_\_\_ to motivate Pharaoh to release the Israelites, culminating in the plague of the \_\_\_\_\_.

- God initiated the first Passover and called the Israelites to put the blood of a defect-free \_\_\_\_\_ on the doorposts, marking that they were God's people.
- God called the Israelites to celebrate the \_\_\_\_\_ each year to remember what He had done. The Passover was where Jesus introduced the Lord's Supper.

God used \_\_\_\_\_ signs to gain glory and so the Israelites would trust Him & Moses.

- **Ex. 14:31** - *Israel saw the great power that the LORD used against the Egyptians, so the people feared the LORD, and they believed in the LORD and in His servant Moses.*

**Exodus 16-17** - Despite their freedom, the Israelites immediately begin to \_\_\_\_\_ and wish they had died in Egypt---God meets them with \_\_\_\_\_ through water, food, and victory!

**Exodus 19-20** - God has rescued Israel and gives them the covenant of the 10 \_\_\_\_\_. God promises Israel will be His treasured possession through obedience.

- The 10 commandments are a \_\_\_\_\_ covenant that will be fulfilled by the New Covenant in Jesus' blood.
- **Matthew 22:34-40** - Jesus sums up the 10 commandments---love \_\_\_\_\_ and love your \_\_\_\_\_ as \_\_\_\_\_.

**Exodus 25** - God commands the Israelites to build Him a \_\_\_\_\_, so that He may dwell among them. This temporary, portable worship venue travels with them throughout the desert.

\_\_\_\_\_ - An explanation of the law for worship, but also includes government & society.

\_\_\_\_\_ - An account of the census of Israel & journey from Mount Sinai to Promised Land.

- **Numbers 13 - 12**\_\_\_\_\_ (leaders of the tribes) are sent into Canaan to explore the Promised Land. They return and report the land is incredible, but are afraid & don't enter.
- This generation will wander for \_\_\_\_\_ years in the desert, until they die off---only Caleb & Joshua will enter the Promised Land

\_\_\_\_\_ - A collection of sermons by Moses, repeating Israel's history, which ends with Moses dying outside the Promised Land.
