Throughout the Bible we hear about manifestations of God's glory, which are frequently described as light. There is no doubt that Israel had its share of struggles and dark times – but God promised to guide them with the light. The light of the Lord exposes the darkness and overcomes the fears and doubts of God's people with His presence.

This month we enter the season of Epiphany, a season where we celebrate God revealing his light to all nations through Jesus Christ. For the wise men, the light of the star led them to Jesus. God's light comes to us like it did the Magi—through God's Word illuminating our lives and through the Sacraments of Baptism and the Lord's Supper that place God's light of faith within us. It is that Light, Jesus Christ, who has guided our feet and illumined our lives, that we are empowered then to share the love of Christ in our homes, where we work and go to school, and in our communities. We share a light of love, a light of compassion, a light of hope.

I encourage you to consider these questions:

- In what ways can I more closely be guided by the light of God's Word?
- What are ways I can let God's light shine in the midst of the darkness in my family, in my workplace, at my school?
- Who in my life can I tangibly share the love of Christ?
- How is our church being called to be a light in the midst of the darkness of this neighborhood?

Coffee Hour


