The Book of Exodus: Let My People Go!



Lent begins with Ash Wednesday on February 14, 2024 and so does our congregational Lenten emphasis on Moses' most famous book—Exodus. In the book of Exodus, Moses asks Pharaoh to let God's people go seven times *(Exodus 5:1;* 7:16; 8:1, 20; 9:1, 13; 10:3) and Pharaoh finally does it! When he does, God's deliverance and salvation is so

amazing that the event becomes the Gospel of the Old Testament. Israel's Scriptures mention the exodus 125 times!

One of the key take-aways from the account of Exodus is that God desires to liberate all humanity, and even all of creation, from what binds us—from what enslaves us and from what holds us captive. Maybe fear imprisons us. Maybe the need for control holds us confined. Maybe the thirst for power cages us in unhealthy patterns of life. Maybe greed holds us enslaved. Humanity has long been held captive and enslaved to all of these throughout history.

The Exodus account contrasts the Reign of Pharaoh and the Reign of God. In the Reign of Pharaoh, a fearful, violent tyrant was in charge. Pharaoh's reign depended upon the enslavement of an entire people for hundreds of years. And it was obsessed with production (make bricks; build stuff; amass power, territory, and wealth).



In contrast, what does the Reign of God look like? What would the world look like if our loving God was in charge? Instead of enslavement, God desires our liberation – our collective liberation from all those things that bind us. And God will go to great lengths to free us.

Throughout the book of Exodus God reveals who he is through his absence and his presence, through his silence and his speech, through his wrath and his mercy, and through his judgment and his amazing grace. In doing so, the book paints a beautiful portrait of *Jesus*. Jesus liberates us from our sin through his suffering, death on the cross, and glorious resurrection. Jesus delivers us from all that holds us captive and calls us to follow him into true freedom.

This Lent, be sure to make room in your lives to attend the Lenten Suppers starting at 5:00pm followed by Lenten midweek worship at 6:30pm. There will also be a special Lenten devotional booklet based on Exodus. Pick one up for yourself and consider sharing one with a friend!

Looking forward to journeying with you this Lent out of slavery into the freedom of Christ!

The first VBS planning meeting February 17 at 10:00 am in the Youth Room.


