Winning the War in Your Mind

The life you have is a reflection of what you think. Like whitewater rapids rushing you downstream, your thoughts move your life in the direction of their strongest currents. The thoughts you believe, hold onto, and use to support your decisions determine your view of everything and everyone around you, including yourself.

The truth is...You probably don't stop and think about the power your thoughts have over your life—which only increases the power they have to determine your decisions and shape your actions. Simply put, what you think determines what you believe. Every thought in your brain produces a neurochemical change in your mind. And these thoughts shape your life. Once your thoughts determine what you believe, these beliefs then determine how you behave. In many ways, you become what you think about. Therefore, the better you grasp the importance of your thoughts, the better equipped you'll be to change your life in powerful ways.

This battle over our mind is called a WAR because we face an enemy, the devil, who wants to kill you—but he can't—at least not physically. But the devil can lie to you and to me.

Incidentally, his lies are his fiercest weapon. Words are powerful. They have the ability to hurt or heal. God creates with his true and living word; the devil demolishes with his. This "father of lies" (John 8:44) wants us to doubt God's promises, just as Adam and Eve did: "Did God actually say?" (Gen 3:1). He tries to lead us away from the entire truth with his manipulation—and he uses partial truths to do so. All lies are manipulations of the truth, and that is precisely why they are so compelling and believable. When we believe the devil's distortions of the truth, our perception of reality becomes skewed.

God's word alone must remain our filter in deciphering the meaning of life's events; it must be the principal instrument through which we view our world. The devil is highly skilled at confirming the negative things we think about ourselves. He blows them out of proportion in hopes that they may eclipse the cross of Jesus.

Even as scientists and neurologists continue to confirm the power our thoughts have on us, God told us this truth more than 1,500 years ago: "For as [a person] thinks in his heart, so he is" (Proverbs 23:7 NKJV). God knows that what we focus on mentally affects every aspect of our lives because he created us that way.

This June, Pastor Andy will be preaching a sermon series on Winning the War in Your Mind. Drawing on God's Word and the power of the Holy Spirit living in each of us, we will be challenged to



"take captive every thought to make it obedient to Christ" (2 Corinthians 10:5). The Lord invites us to meditate on His words and to consider what God has done (Psalm 143:5). Instead of being conformed to the pattern of this world, God wants us to be transformed by the renewing of our mind (Romans 12:2). One of the ways we defeat negative thoughts is by reframing the troubles of this world in light of God's promises to deliver us and to work good out of all things for the sake of those who love him (Romans 8:28). When we are anxious, the Lord gently invites us to present our requests to Him. (Philippians 4:6). The goal of this sermon series is that each of us may experience "the peace of God, which transcends all understanding," and that peace "will guard your hearts and minds in Jesus Christ" (Philippians 4:7).

We've all tried to think our way out of bad habits and unhealthy thought patterns, only to find ourselves stuck with an out-of-control mind and off-track daily life. You didn't expect to be here. You didn't mean to become a prisoner to the negative thoughts and patterns your thought-life has built. God has something better for your life than your old ways of thinking. It's time to seek God's help to win the war in your mind. Come worship this June and let your minds be transformed by the forgiveness and grace Jesus Christ won for you on the cross!
