HOPE for TODAY!


What should we make of all the events of today? Let us turn to God's word for HOPE for today and everyday! In Matthew 24, Jesus told his disciples:

"Watch out that no one deceives you. For many will come in my name, claiming, 'I am the Christ,' and will deceive many. You will hear of wars and rumors of wars, but see to it that you are not alarmed. Such things must happen, but the end is still to come...Because of the increase of wickedness, the love of most will grow cold, but he who stands firm to the end will be saved." (Matthew 24:4-6, 12-13)

As redeemed children of God, we do not need to be alarmed by the events of this world. The Lord is in control of human events in this world. This is one of the realities that has really stuck with me as we have been studying the book of

Daniel on Sunday mornings. God is in control.

I want to share with you four truths the Lord reveals through the vision He gave to Daniel (Daniel 7):

First, God governs all world history for the sake of his kingdom of grace. God's Kingdom of Grace consists of his redeemed people in the Christian Churches on earth. In Daniel 7 the LORD reveals to Daniel a vision of four beasts, or a succession of four different kingdoms. This demonstrates God's foreknowledge of human events and that God is in control of history. This assurance of God's governance comforts us, even as we live in circumstances beyond our control and when we feel like the world is spinning out of control. Disciples of Jesus should not be surprised or alarmed when they are persecuted and experience evil in the world. We should trust that God is guiding all believers ultimately for the sake of our redemption! Take a look at John 16:33; Romans 8:28, 35-39; and Revelation 1:1, 9.

A second emphasis is that God's kingdom comes through the ministry of the personal Messiah, who establishes and receives the authority over this eternal kingdom. While Daniel experienced a vision of the coming of the Son of Man, we can revel at the reality of Jesus' birth, ministry, death on the cross and glorious resurrection. God's kingdom is one marked by faith in Jesus Christ. His Kingdom, the Christian Church on earth, began on the day of Pentecost with



the outpouring of the Holy Spirit. The devil and all the forces of evil cannot overcome Jesus Christ's church on earth.

The third emphasis is the benefit God's people receive from the personal Messiah and the establishment of His kingdom. The kingdom that is given to the Son of Man becomes the possession inherited by the "saints." In New

Testament language, all baptized believers in Christ receive what properly belongs to Christ himself: his righteousness and the forgiveness of sins Jesus earned by his sacrificial death on the cross; the promise to reign with Him for eternity (see Romans 5:17 and Revelation 22:3-5). All of this is summed up in the acclamation of the Lamb in Revelation 5:9-10.

"You are worthy to take the scroll and to open its seals, because you were slain, and with your blood you purchased men for God from every tribe and language and people and nation. You have made them to be a kingdom and priests to serve our God, and they will reign on the earth."

A fourth emphasis has to do with the End Times. In the vision Daniel receives, he sees the whole span of history as the coming of the Son of Man, Jesus Christ, who receives the kingdom from the Ancient of Days (God the Father), and in turn gives the kingdom to His saints, His church consisting of all believers. When Jesus Christ returns, the final judgment will take place and the evil of this world will be destroyed forever in a fiery judgment. God's saints then take possession of the eternal kingdom in the new heaven and new earth (Revelation 21-22).

We can be assured that God is control over all events among humans. God has a plan for our redemption. Even when we face trials and hardships and persecutions, our hope lies in our future eternal glorification (Romans 8:30).

May the Lord strengthen your faith as we fix our eyes on Jesus and wait for His return.

Butterfly Garden






