#### Jesus - I AM



As we journey through Lent this year, the Gospel of John offers us a treasure trove of comfort and certainty in the words of our Savior. Among its many riches are the seven "I Am" statements of Jesus—powerful

declarations that reveal who He is and what He graciously provides for us, His people. Rooted in the Old Testament name of God, "I AM" (Exodus 3:14), these statements show us that Jesus is no mere teacher or prophet, but the eternal Son of God, come to deliver us from sin, death, and the devil.

When Jesus uses the "I AM" language, He boldly claims His divine identity. Each statement illuminates a different aspect of Christ's relationship with believers and His saving work. Our cries of "I am empty" are met with "I am the bread of life." Our pleas of "I am lost" are countered with "I am the way, the truth, and the life." Two simple words

addressing every one of our fears, doubts, and pain: I AM.

#### "I Am" Sunday Morning Lenten Sermon Series

#### March 9 - "I am the bread of life" (John 6:35)

Just as physical bread sustains our bodies, Jesus nourishes our souls. After feeding the 5,000, Jesus explained that He provides spiritual sustenance that truly satisfies. In Holy Communion, we receive this bread of life as Christ comes to us in, with, and under the elements.

#### March 16 - "I am the light of the world" (John 8:12)

In a world darkened by sin, Jesus illuminates our path to the Father. Through His Word, we find guidance, truth, and the ability to recognize our sin and His salvation.

#### March 23 - "I am the door" (John 10:7)

Christ is the exclusive entrance to salvation. Through Baptism and faith, we enter His fold and receive eternal protection.

#### March 30 - "I am the good shepherd" (John 10:11)

Unlike hired hands who abandon their flocks, Jesus willingly laid down His life for us. He knows each of His sheep by name and leads us through all of life's valleys.

#### April 6 - "I am the way, the truth, and the life" (John

**14:6**) In our pluralistic world, Jesus' exclusive claim stands firm: He alone bridges the gap between sinful humanity and the holy Father.

#### April 13 - "I am the true vine" (John 15:1)

Connected to Christ, we bear fruit. Apart from Him, we can do nothing. Through Word and Sacrament, we remain grafted to the vine, receiving His life-giving grace.

April 20 – EASTER "I am the resurrection and the life" (John 11:25) Before raising Lazarus, Jesus declared His power over death. Through His own resurrection, He guarantees that all who believe in Him will live eternally.




These "I Am" statements are more than poetic words; they are divine promises. Throughout this season of Lent, we cling to the certainty that Christ speaks them still—to us, for us—in the preaching of the Gospel and the celebration of the Sacraments. Here, in worship, Jesus meets us as Bread, Light, Door, Shepherd, Way, Vine, and Resurrection, sustaining us until He returns.

So, dear friends, as life presses in with its challenges, take heart. The great "I AM" has claimed you as His own in Baptism, forgiven you through His blood, and will never leave you. Rest in His words, and let them echo in your hearts: "I am... everything you need."

# 2025 LENTEN MIDWEEK SERMON SERIES



Gathered by the waters of Babylon, Judean exiles wistfully wondered: Is God for real? If so, does He really care about us? What does our future hold? Will this ever change? God's people had watched their world shatter into a million pieces. They were demoralized and disillusioned. Their disaster looked terminal.

Do you feel this way? Does it look as though your current problems are more than you can bear? Do you find yourself asking: Why did this happen? Why did God allow it? Is there any order in the world? Will God really deliver on what He said?

Isaiah answers these questions in chapters 40–55 of his book. He announces that just when Israel's history seemed closed and controlled by hopeless Babylonian imperial policy, to the shock and surprise of everyone the Lord will stir up a king named Cyrus and a new exodus will explode in the desert! A Servant will be wounded for our transgressions and crushed for our iniquities. And barren Zion will be given so many children that, like the old woman in the shoe, she won't know what to do!

Standing behind these marvelous promises is God's almighty Word. "The grass withers, the flower fades, but the word of our God will stand forever" (Isaiah 40:8). The exiles are going home!




#### TLC Book Club

#### **Operation Christmas Child**







The connection between COOPERATION and GOD's CHARACTER as shown through God's story.




