What an incredible week we had at True North Vacation Bible School June 9-13! Over 60 children embarked on an unforgettable Alaskan adventure, discovering that no matter what challenges life brings, we can always **TRUST JESUS!** Against the backdrop of northern lights, majestic mountains, and wilderness wonders, our young explorers learned that Jesus is our True North—our faithful guide through every situation.

Throughout the week, our children didn't just play—they encountered Jesus in meaningful ways.

Day 1 - When We Wonder, We Can Trust Jesus

Our adventure began with John the Baptist preparing the way for Jesus. Children learned from Matthew 7:24 that "Anyone who listens to my teaching and follows it is wise," setting the foundation for our week of trusting in Jesus.

Day 2 - When We Feel Alone, We Can Trust Jesus

Clawdia the Crab taught us about Jesus' invitation in Matthew 11:28: "Come to me, all of you who are weary and carry heavy burdens, and I will give you rest." Our campers created beautiful Northern Lights on lanterns in Arctic Art and enjoyed delicious Bear Foot Feast cookies (homemade chocolate chip paw print cookies!). The highlight was our Cool Cube experiment in Compass Closing, where wiggly cubes seemed to disappear in water, showing that Jesus is always with us—even when we feel invisible.



Day 3 - When We Feel Powerless, We Can Trust Jesus

Kody the Bear reminded us of Jesus' words from Matthew 14:27: "Don't be afraid. Take courage. I am here!" Children made "God Guides Me" bracelets and played "The Trail is Lava" while learning to take courage during scary times. A powerful Roman soldier visited us in Wild Bible Adventures, demonstrating faith and trust in Jesus' power. We enjoyed Bear Paw treats and the beautiful weather during Glacier Games.



Day 4 - When We Need Hope, We Can Trust Jesus

Earnest the Eagle shared the truth from Matthew 12:21: "And his name will be the hope of all the world." Through a powerful ice cube activity, children held onto "icy sins" and watched them melt with God's forgiving love. They created personalized camping scenes in Arctic Art and received glowsticks as gifts from Jesus, reminding them that we don't have to live in darkness when we come to Jesus. The dramatic reminder of Jesus' death and resurrection brought home the eternal hope we have in Christ.

Day 5 - When We Need Help, We Can Trust Jesus

Bruce the Moose concluded our adventure with Jesus' promise from Matthew 28:20: "I am with you always, even to the end of the age." Children experienced the wild wind and fiery flames of Pentecost, learning how the Holy Spirit came to be our helper. They finished their lantern art and received special Alaskan ornament keepsakes to remember their True North VBS experience. An egg-citing experiment reminded them that while things don't always go perfectly, we can always trust Jesus and find comfort in His presence.

In our rapidly changing world, children face uncertainties that can feel overwhelming. True North VBS equipped our young ones with the knowledge that Jesus is their constant compass—always faithful, always present, always trustworthy. Please bring your own chairs and blankets and something to share for a potluck picnic.


The concert will take place near the Main Shelter.




TLC Book Club



THE MUSIC MINISTRY




