

#### Something Better

As December unfolds and we prepare our hearts for Christmas, I'm excited to share our Advent sermon series: "Something Better." In a season when we're bombarded with messages about finding the perfect gifts, the book of Hebrews reminds us that God has already given us something infinitely better than we could ever imagine—His Son, Jesus Christ.

The book of Hebrews was written to Christians facing persecution around 64 AD, when following Christ had become dangerous under Emperor Nero. These believers were tempted to return to their old ways, to choose what seemed safer and more comfortable. The author's response? **Don't go backward—you have something better in Christ!** 

This message resonates powerfully today. When life gets difficult, when faith feels costly, when we're tempted to rely on our own strength or return to old patterns, Hebrews calls us forward with this truth: In Christ, we have something better than anything this world offers.

Each week of Advent, we'll discover how Christ surpasses the remarkable gifts God gave through Moses and the Old Testament:

#### December 3 - "A Better Word" (Hebrews 1:1-2) 6:30 pm

God spoke powerfully through the prophets, but now He speaks through His Son. While the Old Testament gave us a "sonogram" of God's promises, Jesus is the full revelation—God's final Word of love and redemption spoken from a manger, a cross, and an empty tomb.

#### December 10 - "A Better Glory" (Hebrews 1:3a) 6:30 pm

Israel experienced God's glory in the cloud that guided, protected, and provided for them. But we have something better—Jesus Himself, "the radiance of God's glory and the exact representation of His being." We have Someone who fights all our battles and never leaves us alone.

#### December 17 - "A Better Absolution" (Hebrews 1:3b) 6:30 pm

The Old Testament sacrifices provided temporary purification, repeated day after day, year after year. But Christ "provided purification for sins" once and for all, then "sat down"—His work complete! No more guilt trips necessary. In Christ, we're clean, forgiven, absolutely absolved.


#### December 24 - "A Better Name" (Hebrews 1:4-14) 6:30 pm & 10:00 pm

Angels are magnificent, but Jesus inherited a name far superior to theirs. He is Son, Firstborn, God, Lord, and Victor. His name—Jesus, "The LORD saves"—contains everything we need for hope and salvation.

#### **Living with Something Better**

This December, as you navigate the stress of shopping, family gatherings, and year-end pressures, remember: you already possess something better than any wrapped package under a tree. You have Christ, who:

- Speaks a better word of hope when life feels overwhelming
- Provides better glory through His constant presence
- Offers better absolution that frees you from guilt and shame
- Bears a better name that guarantees your salvation



As Hebrews 11:40 promises, "God has planned something better for us!" This Christmas, let's celebrate not just what we hope to receive, but what we've already been given in Christ—something infinitely, eternally better.


If there is enough interest for child care for littles we are happy to organize an option for that as well. Just let us know!



#### Holiday Lantern Tours at Hale Farm & Village


