## The Book of Job: Blessed be the Name of the Lord

*A Lenten Journey Through  
Suffering, Faith, and Grace*


**"The Lord gave, and the Lord has taken away;  
blessed be the name of the Lord."** Job 1:21

This Lent, beginning on Ash Wednesday, February 18, we will embark on a Lenten journey through one of the Bible's most profound and challenging books—the Book of Job. Martin Luther called Job "magnificent and sublime as no book of Scripture," while the early Christian scholar Jerome famously described it as an "eel"—the more you try to grasp it, the more it slips away! Our purpose this Lent is to learn how to apply Job to our lives, so that this ancient wisdom becomes less like a slippery eel and more like a trusted companion through life's darkest valleys.

One of the most challenging aspects of life is dealing with and making sense of suffering. Because we all suffer—privately and publicly. A husband loses a job. A child's marriage ends in divorce. A parent dies. And in our media-saturated age, we witness countless catastrophes and tragedies from around the world. We need the book of Job now more than ever.

**Why Job? Why Now?** The book of Job stands as a microcosm of the entire biblical story. It begins in paradise, describes a diabolical intrusion and devastating fall, announces God's powerful intervention, and pictures a restoration even greater than the beginning. Sound familiar? Job's story is our story—and ultimately, it's Christ's story too.

But here's what might surprise you: The book of Job isn't primarily about answering the question "Why do the righteous suffer?" Instead, it asks a more fundamental question: "Why do the righteous serve God?" Do we serve Him because of rewards, or out of loving gratitude for His grace? The accuser (Satan) wagers that suffering will


cause us to renounce God. Job proves him wrong—and in doing so, points us to the One who would endure infinitely greater suffering for our sake.

In Hebrew the word "Job" actually means "enemy." At various points, Job feels that God has become his enemy, or is treating him as one. In this way, Job represents every believer who, in moments of suffering, weakness, or doubt, struggles to trust God's goodness and wisdom. If you've ever felt that way—and who hasn't?—then Job's story is your story. This Lent, we won't find easy answers to suffering's mysteries. But we will find something better: a God who meets us in the storm, who never abandons His children, and who gives us a Redeemer who lives. We will learn to lament honestly, to surrender humbly, and to trust ultimately—not because suffering makes sense, but because God is good.

I invite you to join us on Wednesday evenings and during Holy Week as we wrestle with Job's questions and discover Job's faith. Bring your own struggles, your honest doubts, and your deepest longings. This ancient book speaks powerfully to our modern lives, and together we'll learn what it means to say with Job, even in our darkest hours: "Blessed be the name of the Lord."



Follow Jesus during the week leading up to Good Friday. Angel Studios has created an engaging account of Jesus' ministry in a mini-series called "The Chosen." Come watch and experience **season 5** of *The Chosen* at TLC on Thursday nights starting on Thursday, February 5, 2026. Each Thursday we will watch one episode starting at 6:30pm in the Sanctuary.

## Thursday, February 5, 6:30 pm – 7:45 pm

**EPISODE 1 – Entry** *John 16:16-33; 17:1-4; Ps. 118:19-23*

Jesus rides into the Holy City as King, but finds that the rulers have turned His Father's House from a place of prayer to a corrupt market.

## Thursday, February 12, 6:30 pm – 7:45 pm

**EPISODE 2 – House of Cards** *Matt. 26:31-35; Luke 22:31-34; Matt. 26:35; John 15:13; Mark 11:15-19*

Why kill Jesus when Rome can do it for you? As the Jewish High Priest schemes to bring Him down, Jesus strikes first: turning the tables.

## Thursday, February 19, 6:30 pm – 7:45 pm

**EPISODE 3 – Woes** *John 13:36b; 14:1-29; 13:37-38a; Matt. 21:23-46; Psalm 5*

Jesus preaches one last time to the massive Passover crowd, and the religious leaders try to trap Him in His words.

## Thursday, February 26, 6:30 pm – 7:45 pm

**EPISODE 4 – The Same Coin** *John 13:18-30, 33-36a; Matt. 21:18-22*

Afraid of public outcry—and further embarrassment—Caiaphas resolves to arrest Jesus quietly at night. Only one problem: no one knows how to find Him.

## Thursday, March 5, 6:30 pm – 7:45 pm

**EPISODE 5 – Because of Me** *Matt. 26:22; John 13:23-24; Luke 22:23-30; Mark 11:12-25*

The decision to arrest Jesus leads to a fiery debate. Roman soldiers track down a troublemaking crowd. Shmuel finds help from an unexpected source.

## Thursday, March 12, 6:30 pm – 7:45 pm

**EPISODE 6 - Reunions** *Matthew 26:20-30; John 15:1-17*

As Jesus' followers gather for the Passover meal, His enemies assemble for a man hunt. Judas holds a secret meeting.

## Thursday, March 19, 6:30 pm – 7:45 pm

**EPISODE 7 - The Upper Room: Part 1** *John 13:1-17; Isa. 52:7*

Jesus and the disciples celebrate Hanukkah. Matthew confronts Judas about irregularities, and the festival turns into a fight, then flight. The disciples escape with their lives, but learn a friend hasn't been so lucky.

## Thursday, March 26, 6:30 pm – 7:45 pm

**EPISODE 8 - The Upper Room: Part 2** *Matthew 26:17-56; Ezek. 37:1-14*

Pilate summons Atticus to read him the riot act. The Sanhedrin boils over. The Last Supper ends.

## TLC Book Club

The book for February is *And Take They Our Life: Martin Luther's Theology of Martyrdom* by Bryan Wolfmueller.

This book digs into Luther's understanding of Christian suffering and death, and preaches Christ to fainting hearts, so that we too would joyfully face persecution, suffering, and even death, knowing that Jesus waits for us.






